

Dear Planning Inspectorate.

With the re-engineering of the River Nene floodplain something that should not happen because Historic England claimed for many years a burial barrow near to the existing A47, the point this occurs on the river is a near 90 degree turn. During the majority of the time the river is relatively slow moving as it meanders through this part of the valley however during times of flooding when the dynamics of the river are flowing faster will this now erode the banks much faster especially as its on a sharp bend, near the outflow of Wittering Brook and the land level has been reduced allowing faster water to move onto the new floodplain. Found no references to changes in River dynamics with erosion and deposition from any agency.
