*Natural England* - a draft SoCG has been developed and shared with Natural England.

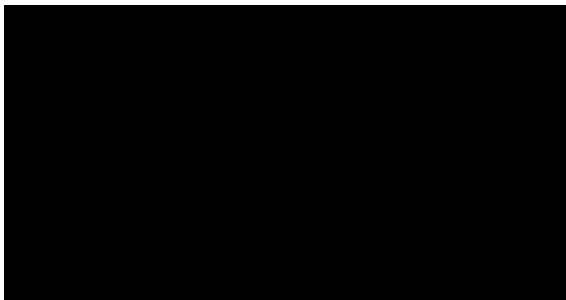
*Historic England* - a draft SoCG has been developed and shared with Historic England.
