



Norfolk County Council's Comments on the: Highways England - A47 Blofield to Burlingham Draft Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC)

28 August 2018

- 1. Introduction
- 1.1. Norfolk County Council welcomes the opportunity to comment on the SoCC prepared by Highways England for the above Junction Improvements.
- 2. Comments
- 2.1. The officer-level comments below are made on a without prejudice basis and the County Council reserves the right to make further comments on the emerging application / Development Consent Order (DCO) at the appropriate consultation stages.
- 2.2. General The County Council supports the consultation arrangement set out in the draft SoCC, particularly since it seeks to ensure that the local community, residents, local interest groups, businesses, visitors, and road users will have an opportunity to fully understand the scheme and comment on the proposal. The SoCC has a range of consultation methods including exhibitions, use of social media and drop-in information points, which are considered appropriate and are therefore welcomed.
- 2.3. Additional Consultees While the list of stakeholders in the SoCC is considered reasonable, it is felt that it should be expanded to include the following;
 - Under Adjoining Local Authorities (appendix 2) the following should be included: Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk, Waveney District Council and Midsuffolk District Council.
 - Under Local affected and adjoining Parish Councils (appendix 3) the following should be included: Surlingham, Cantley, Freethorpe, Halvergate and South Walsham.
 - Under Local and District Councillors (appendix 3) the following members should be included: Vic James Thomson (Henstead) and Ian James Mackie (Thorpe St Andrew).
 - Under Non-statutory bodies (appendix 3) the A47 Alliance should be added.
 - Under Media (appendix 3) the following should be included: Norwich Evening News, East Anglia Times, BBC Norfolk and ITV News Anglia.
 - An additional heading should be added to appendix 3 under the heading Transport and Road Associations to include: the Freight and Transport Association and the Road Haulage Association.
- 2.4. Although the above additions will increase the scope of the consultation Norfolk County Council is unaware the impacts scheme could have the wider transport network, therefore, there could be a requirement for the inclusion of consultees in

Thank you for inviting Great Yarmouth Borough Council to comment on the draft Statement of Community Consultation for the A47 Blofield to North Burlingham dualling.

As a member of the A47 Alliance, we are encouraged to see progress on this project and welcome the forthcoming consultation to move closer to construction of this improvement to the trunk road network.

The Borough Council has no concerns in principle to this document in its current form; however, we wish to make the following minor comments for clarification:

In Paragraph 3.7 it is mentioned that "The need for improvements in this location is echoed by the Norfolk Local Transport Plan, Greater Norwich Joint Core Strategy and Highways England's East of Route Strategy, and is also supported by Norfolk County Council, Broadland District Council and the A47 Alliance Group". Great Yarmouth Borough Council also remains fully supportive of future proposals to dual the A47, this being clearly stated within Policy CS16 of our adopted Local Plan Core Strategy.

In Paragraph 4.6 it mentions that "Notices to be publicised in key business locations within Norwich and the surrounding area". For the avoidance of doubt, may we reiterate that the 'surrounding area' should include Great Yarmouth, particularly as dualling would bring great benefit to the businesses operating within Great Yarmouth.



In Appendix 3 we ask that:

- The Rt Hon Brandon Lewis is included as a consultee
- Natural England are consulted

Great Yarmouth Borough Council would also welcome the opportunity to receive a briefing session on the proposed scheme for both Council members and officers.
