Highways England Limited of Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, GU1 4LZ ("the Applicant") has published a Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC) in accordance with Section 47(6) of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended by section 134 of the Localism Act 2011) (the Act).

The Applicant is seeking a Development Consent Order (DCO) for the proposed A47 Blofield to North Burlingham dualling (the Project). A DCO is required due to the Project being a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP).

The DCO would authorise the construction of a new stretch of dual carriageway south of the existing alignment, two new overbridges and associated works to connect the new stretch of road.

The Project is an Environmental Impact Assessment development and so the Applicant will prepare an Environmental Statement to accompany the application to the Planning Inspectorate. A Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR) has been produced (to describe the environmental effects of the scheme) and is being consulted on alongside the other consultation documents.


