Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing Section 48(1) Planning Act 2008 Regulation 13 Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017

My letter of 17 August 2018 notified you that Norfolk County Council intends to make an application under the Planning Act 2008 for a Development Consent Order (DCO) in order to obtain the necessary consents to construct, operate and maintain the Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing.

Due to its nature and size, the Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing scheme is EIA development for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 ("the EIA Regulations"). It will therefore require environmental impact assessment under the EIA Regulations and an Environmental Statement (ES) will accompany the application for a DCO.

As part of the EIA process, and in accordance with Regulation 13 of the EIA Regulations, a copy of the Section 48 Notice was enclosed with my original letter. This notice was subsequently published on the dates detailed in my letter and details of the scheme proposals, including preliminary environmental information in the form of a Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR), was made available for inspection between 20 August 2018 and 5 October 2018.

During the consultation, we became aware that volume II of the PEIR as published had 21 figures (plans) missing. In response to this, we are extending the consultation deadline to make sure people are aware of the issue and have plenty of time to consider and comment on the figures alongside the published consultation documents. The new deadline for responses to this consultation is 23:59hrs on Sunday 9 December 2018.

Extension of deadline for responses



The Notice published on 24 August 2018 gave notice that Norfolk County Council ("The Council") of County Hall, Martineau Lane, Norwich NR1 2DH proposed to apply to the Secretary of State under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 for an order granting development consent for the Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing ("The Third River Crossing").

The Third River Crossing will be EIA development for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations. It will therefore require environmental impact assessment and an Environmental Statement will accompany the application for a Development Consent Order. Details of the scheme proposals, including preliminary environmental information in the form of a Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR), were previously made available for inspection between 20 August 2018 and 5 October 2018. However, the Council has become aware that Volume II of the published PEIR omitted 21 figures (plans). These figures are now being made available as detailed below.

In light of the missing figures now being made available, the deadline for responses to this consultation has been extended to 23:59hrs on Sunday 9 December 2018. The Council will welcome responses to any aspect of the Third River Crossing proposals, not just the missing figures.

The missing figures, together with the previously published consultation documents, including scheme details and preliminary environmental information, are available for inspection free of charge between 22 October 2018 and 9 December 2018 at the locations below.
