**Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing
Formal Consultation under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 — extension of
consultation period**

My letter of 6 September 2018 formally consulted you under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 on Norfolk County Council's proposals for the Great Yarmouth Third River Crossing. Enclosed with the letter was a memory stick that contained the consultation documents, including a Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR). Please note that when using the memory stick the documents may appear under the 'CD-ROM (D:)' drive.

During the consultation, we became aware that volume II of the PEIR as published had 21 figures (plans) missing. In response to this, we are extending the consultation deadline to make sure people are aware of the issue and have plenty of time to consider and comment on the figures alongside the published consultation documents.

What is a PEIR?

The PEIR details the current proposals for the proposed scheme and explains the methods and preliminary findings of our assessment of the environmental effects of the proposals. Its purpose is to help consultees develop an informed view of the likely significant environmental effects of the proposals. Those views will help the Council to prepare the statutory Environmental Statement, which will accompany the application for a Development Consent Order (DCO).

Where can I see the figures that were missing?

Enclosed is a copy of all the figures that were missing from the original PEIR document. For practical reasons of postage, we have had to supply these at a small scale (A4 size) but full-size versions are available on request, or you can download pdfs of the documents at www.norfolk.gov.uk/3rcconsultation.

Due to the publication of these missing figures, and to allow consultees time to consider and respond to them, the new deadline for responses to this consultation is **23:59hrs on Sunday 9 December 2018**. We will welcome responses to any aspects of the consultation, not just the missing figures.

Please note that we do not anticipate that the extension to the consultation period will affect the overall project timescales and we still expect to submit a DCO application for examination by the Secretary of State, via the Planning Inspectorate, in Spring 2019.
