Dear Sir or Madam

The Great Yarmouth Port Authority (GYPA), the statutory Port and Harbour Authority for the River Yare, wish to refer to its relevant representation which was received on 1 August 2019. The concerns outlined therein remain outstanding.

Meetings have taken place in relation to the safe operation of the harbour but full details including the report from HR Wallingford remain to be seen by GYPA.

Regrettably no progress has been made in respect of the concerns outlined in the Relevant Representation regarding the lay-by berth for inbound vessels into the Inner Harbour. It is feared that the bridge will have to remain open for 30 minutes if an inbound ship is to be brought into the harbour if no such lay-by berth is provided by the applicant, Norfolk County Council.
