We act on behalf of Perenco UK Limited.


Our Client has been actively working towards a solution acceptable to all related parties. Our Client has been in discussions with Norfolk County Council, ASCO, Great Yarmouth Borough Council and Great Yarmouth Port Company for a number of months.

A Statement of Common Ground with Norfolk County Council had been prepared but on the basis that the Norfolk County Council, ASCO, Great Yarmouth Borough Council, Great Yarmouth Port Company and our Client would have entered into an infrastructure agreement whereby appropriate mitigation arrangements would have been put in place for Perenco's partial relocation (next to its existing site) and that these would have enabled Perenco to stay in Great Yarmouth.

Since the agreement has not now been put in place, our Client has been put into some difficulty and the proposed Statement of Common Ground cannot be submitted.

Our Client continues to discuss the position with the Council to remedy the situation and enable our Client to remain in Great Yarmouth in the event that the Application is successful.

Our Client is reviewing their position and will seek to agree a revised Statement of Common Ground with the Council. However without any Agreement or agreed form Statement of Common Ground, our Client's position as detailed in their previous representations remains.
