Draft Development Consent Order (draft DCO)**

Dear Sir / Madam

We refer to the above application for development consent. References to the draft DCO in this letter are to the draft Order version 0 dated 31 April 2019. Trinity House respectfully submits a written enquiry at Deadline 2, for the consideration of the Examining Authority, as below.

Schedule 14 (protective provisions), Part 6 (for the protection of Great Yarmouth Port Authority - GYPA) of the draft DCO

Trinity House notes that certain provisions of Part 6 of Schedule 14 relate to matters concerning the safety of navigation, including the provision of lighting for the control of navigation (see in particular paragraphs 57, 64 and 72 of Part 6).

Accordingly, Trinity House seeks clarification please from both the Applicant and GYPA that the provisions of this Part shall not prejudice or derogate from Trinity House's rights, duties or privileges (per article 63 of the draft DCO) and more particularly that Trinity House's powers with respect to lighting under the Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847 Act (which apply to the Port of Great Yarmouth) shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding the provisions of the draft DCO.
