We write with reference to the further information issued by the Examining Authority pursuant to Rule 17 of the above mentioned Act on 13 February 2020 and our subsequent letter dated 21 February 2020.


Additional information in respect of the tidal residual breach analysis was supplied by the Applicant on 19 March 2020. Following review I am able to confirm that the information satisfies Environment Agency concerns; as such our objection to the DCO is withdrawn.


We consider that although the submitted data does not present the fullest picture of the impacts of the proposed development on third parties, and specifically residential properties; it does provide the Examining Authority with sufficient information to make a judgement on flood depths, flood velocities and flood hazard in the areas of additional flood extent in the event of a breach occurring.

We consider that best practice is to provide figures/maps showing the difference in flood depths over the whole flood extent with the bridge infrastructure in situ and not only the superimposed differences on the current day baseline flood extents. The existing figures show the depth of flooding in the event of a breach scenario and are shown alongside the baseline of no bridge we feel that the existing depth difference figures do not show the change in flood depth in additional areas of flood extent that occur as a consequence of the bridge structure being in situ (these areas would previously have been dry). We do, however, note that the ExA may view the flood depth information for those additional inundated areas by looking at the individual flood depth maps.

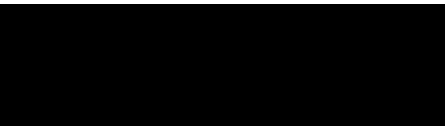
