1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document relates to an application by Highways England to the Secretary of State for Transport under the Planning Act 2008, for the A428 Black Cat to Caxton Gibbet improvements (the Scheme) Development Consent Order.
- 1.1.2 This document has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of Regulation 5(2)(m) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, which sets out:

"where applicable, a plan with accompanying information identifying any statutory or non-statutory sites or features of the historic environment, including scheduled monuments, World Heritage sites, listed buildings and other historic structures, archaeological sites and registered battlefields, together with an assessment of any effects on such sites, features or structures likely to be caused by the proposed development."

- 1.1.3 This document has also been prepared in accordance with the Department for Communities and Local Government guidance, 'Planning Act 2008: Application form guidance' (June 2013).
- 1.1.4 This document sets out where within the application the information required under Regulation 5(2)(m) can be located. As this document is part of a suite of documents, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other application documents. In particular, this document should be read alongside the Environmental Statement **[TR010044/APP/6.1]**.



2 Location of plans and assessment

2.1 Plans

- 2.1.1 Scheduled monuments within the study area are set out in Paragraph 6.11.15 of Chapter 6, Cultural heritage of the Environmental Statement [TR010044/APP/6.1]. They are shown on Figure 6.2 Designated Heritage Assets of the Environmental Statement Figures [TR010044/APP/6.2].
- 2.1.2 There are no World Heritage Sites within the study area, which is confirmed in paragraph 6.11.12 of **Chapter 6**, **Cultural heritage** of the Environmental Statement **[TR010044/APP/6.1]**.
- 2.1.3 Listed buildings within the study area are shown on Figure 6.2 Designated Heritage Assets of the Environmental Statement Figures [TR010044/APP/6.2]. Other historic structures are also shown on Figure 6.2 Designated Heritage Assets of the Environmental Statement Figures [TR010044/APP/6.2]. Table 1-1 Known Heritage Assets within Appendix 6.1 of the Environmental Statement Appendices [TR010044/APP/6.3] provides a summary of the known heritage assets.
- 2.1.4 Archaeological sites are shown on Figure 6.2 Designated Heritage Assets of the Environmental Statement Figures [TR010044/APP/6.2]. Table 1-1 Archaeology Summary Table within Appendix 6.9 of the Environmental Statement [TR010044/APP/6.3] provides a summary of the archaeological sites identified. In addition, archaeological sites located from fieldwork are set out in Appendices 6.3-6.8 of the Environmental Statement [TR010044/APP/6.3].
- 2.1.5 There are no Registered Battlefields within the study area, which is confirmed in paragraph 6.6.13 of Chapter 6, Cultural heritage of the Environmental Statement [TR010044/APP/6.1].

2.2 Assessment

2.2.1 An assessment of the effects on such historic environment sites and features is provided in **Chapter 6, Cultural heritage** of the Environmental Statement **[TR010044/APP/6.1]**.
