## 9.87 Archaeological Mitigation Areas with Evaluation Data – Part 1

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## 1 Purpose of this document

#### 1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document provides figures which show the archaeological mitigation areas, as defined in the Archaeological Mitigation Strategy [REP4-030/031] overlain with the results of the geophysical survey and the evaluation excavation.
- 1.1.2 This document responds to the submission made at Deadline 1 by Historic England in their Written Representation [REP1-077], and again in their response to the Responses to the Examining Authority's Second Written Questions [REP4-069].

#### 1.1.3 Historic England comments

- 1.1.4 In their Written Representation [REP1-077], Historic England stated: "It would have been helpful to see the proposed site areas shown against the cropmark, geophysical survey and evaluation results in order to visually understand them. However, the local authority is best placed to discuss and consider the detail of proposed mitigation."
- 1.1.5 The Applicant's response [REP3-008] stated: "While a plan showing the layout of the mitigation areas against the suite of archaeological evidence was not presented in the AMS [TR010044/EXAM/9.23v2], all data was used in the design of the mitigation areas, and data such as the trenching results and geophysical data was used when discussing the mitigation areas with the local authorities."
- 1.1.6 Within their Responses to the Examining Authority's Second Written Questions [REP4-069], Historic England reiterated this, stating: "If the examining authority requires further comment on the matters under discussion, we would require the applicant to provide maps and plans to illustrate the proposed mitigation areas against the geophysical survey data and the results of trenched evaluation for sites where there is contention, to facilitate our reference back to the original data. We noted in our Written Representation that these plans would be of use (REP1 077bu and REP1 077cp)."
- 1.1.7 The Applicant's comments on other parties' responses to second round of written questions Response [REP5-015] confirmed that the requested figures would be submitted at Deadline 6.
- 1.1.8 This document and its subsequent parts includes the requested figures.
