

On 13 December 2021, Anglian Water (AW) sought to progress unresolved matters with National Highways (NH) solicitors. Those matters were set out in the draft Statement of Common Ground (SoCG). In summary they are:

â€¢ clarity on the powers which will be used by NH to under work on AW assets

â€¢ the loss of funding from NH which AW has to take because its assets are replaced when the don't need to be & the consequence reduction in AW's ability to fund and undertake environmental works elsewhere within the region

â€¢ use of the Inflow system by NH which is used by other developers and which when used then has the flexibility to then enable matters to be progressed offline and directly with AW by NH

AW understands from a call with NH solicitors (12.12.21) that no progress has been possible on these points. AW asks that the Examining Authority request that NH set out a response on these points a final SoCG so that these matters may be concluded before the final deadline for the SoCG on 15.2.22.
