#### 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 The following tables have been prepared by the Applicant to set out the changes made in the First Iteration Environmental Management Plan [REP6-007] from that submitted with the Development Consent Order application [APP-234] to the Planning Inspectorate on 26 February 2021 (herein after referred to as the Schedule of Changes).
- 1.1.2 This Schedule of Changes has been submitted in response to Q3.6.3.1, part (a) [PD-104] which states 'Applicant, set out a schedule of the fundamental changes to the First Iteration EMP'. Table 1-1 below provides the schedule of changes following the submission of an updated version of the First Iteration Environmental Management Plan [REP6-007] at Deadline 6.
- 1.1.3 The updates principally address or take account of the following:
  - a. Drafting errors and corrections.
  - b. Addressing points raised by interested parties, including measures agreed with parties through the development of Statements of Common Ground.
  - c. Updates to terminology and definitions.
  - d. Changes to guidance and best practice.
  - e. The introduction of new management plans (Outline Travel Plan and Borrow Pit Management Plan).
