1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This document (the Schedule of Changes) has been prepared to summarise the main changes made by the Applicant to the First Iteration Environmental Management Plan [APP-234] submitted to the Planning Inspectorate with the Development Consent Order application on 26 February 2021.
- 1.1.2 The Schedule of Changes presents the changes made in Rev 2 [REP6-007] (submitted at Deadline 6), and Rev 3 [TR010044/APP/6.8v3] (submitted at Deadline 9) of the First Iteration Environmental Management Plan.
- 1.1.3 A previous version of the Schedule of Changes (Rev 1) [REP8-023] was submitted at Deadline 8 in response to Q3.6.3.1, part (a) [PD-014] which stated 'Applicant, set out a schedule of the fundamental changes to the First Iteration EMP'.
- 1.1.4 **Table 1-1** presents the changes made to both revisions of the First Iteration Environmental Management Plan [REP6-007] [TR010044APP/6.8v3].
- 1.1.5 The updates principally address or take account of the following:
 - a. Drafting errors, corrections and formatting changes.
 - b. Addressing points raised by interested parties, including measures agreed with parties through the development of Statements of Common Ground.
 - c. Updates to terminology and definitions.
 - d. Changes to guidance and best practice.
 - e. Inclusion of new management plans (Travel Plan and Borrow Pit Management Plan).
 - f. Improved clarity in relation to the delivery and monitoring of certain environmental mitigation and control measures.
 - g. Improved consistency with (and cross-referencing to) other documentation.
 - h. Updates to the current position with regards to consents, licences and permissions (including their disapplication).
