We wish to comment on:

1) The timings of data gathering of Biodiversity, Ecology and Natural Environment information, which is still ongoing, and its use in determining the level of Environmental Mitigation on the scheme.

2) The soundness of baseline data utilised to inform the Environmental Mitigation and the timings of the availability of that data.
