Consequences of the effect of lack of trial trenching at this stage. Potential consequences should remains be discovered in later stages and effect on other mitigation proposals.

	 What is the likely association with Humphrey Repton and whether he influenced the design of the park. What is the likely date for the construction of Lower Pool and associated planting and is there any evidence this could be associated with Repton. How would a change in the view of the significance of Hilton Park affect the overall assessment of the effect of the scheme and the overall conclusion in the ES.
