Good Afternoon,

I have had an updated regarding lead in time for the 360 degree imagery.

We would require 6 weeks notice to ensure we can arrange access, source a 360 degree camera, undertake the recording and trial the output.

Unfortunately the use of a drone would not be possible. We have considered the use of drone footage but found that it would not be appropriate as drones cannot fly within 50m of a highway, therefore views would be taken from a high level and not an equivalent experience to a physical ASI.
