

Thank you for your email of 16 April 2021 regarding the Clarification on route efficacy for the M54 to M6 link road scheme.

In response to your Deadline 9 (Question 5) submission [Ref: Development Consent Order (DCO) document REP9-007], we have reproduced the requested journey time routes table as proposed/annotated by yourself and completed detail below.

Route from M54 J2 to M6 J12 (or vice versa) via:	Time, distance and speed	
	Northbound	Southbound
M54 J2-J1, Scheme from M54 J1 to M6 J11, M6 J11-J12	436s 11,222m 92.7kph	502s 11,525m 82.6kph
A449 from M54 J2 to Gailey Island, A5 from Gailey Island to M6 J12	581s 9,646m 59.8kph	651s 9,978m 55.2kph
A449 from M54 J2 to WMI access road, through WMI site, A5 to M6 J12	601s 9,135m 54.7kph	662s 9,467m 51.5kph

The journey times have been derived from the traffic model produced for the DCO application, with the first two journey time rows produced on the basis of the 2024 opening year model forecasts and the third from differences within 2031 model forecasts, due to the WMI through-route not projected to be fully built until this time. This data provides modelled future journey times for the area requested. We trust that the table and explanatory notes address your Deadline 9 submission question. 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

Thank you for your email.

I'm astonished to learn that when using the retained A449 route the average motorist travels at a speed of 31 to 36 mph between J2-M54 & J12-M6.

We're very fortunate that HE's proposed Shareshill village bypass offers an alternative 58 mph route even with its traffic lights and the inevitable pinch point created by the 'improved' J11-M6 roundabout.
