3 Accompanied Site Inspection 1 (ASI1)

3.1 Stop E

- 3.1.1 The Applicant would like to highlight that Stop E on ASI1 was identified as an area of safety concern due to the land use by the Ministry of Defence as a live firing range.
- 3.1.2 The stop was included at the request of the ExA and Mr Gillham (Winchester Friends of the Earth).
- 3.1.3 Contact with the Ministry of Defence (MoD) has been made. There are no shooting exercises planned for the 10 July. The MoD have however asked to be notified if the Applicant is to walk along the public bridleway through Chilcomb Range in a large group.
- 3.1.4 The Applicant has requested that Stop E be observed from the vehicle with no intention to walk through the firing range.




Figure 1.1 Map of Chilcomb Range (including public bridleways)
