Application by Highways England for an order granting development consent for the A417 Missing Link Project (TR010056)

Appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on 29 June 2021. This document provides confirmation of the Examining Authority that on 16 August 2021 has been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate (on behalf of the Secretary of State) to examine the application.

Initial choice of Panel or single appointed person
