The accidents on the current A417, especially the fatal ones, are becoming increasingly regular. Birdlip is a lovely village community but the traffic risk to our children, the constant and damaging noise and fume pollution, and not to mention the regular speeding vehicles using our village instead of the current A417, needs to be addressed urgently.

Option 12 will not deliver resolutions to these issues, due to the bottleneck that will still happen at the Air Balloon roundabout.
