I fully support Option 30.

This option offers the highest road safety standards in the long term, but of equal importance is road safety and traffic management in the temporary stages of construction. The A417 road has been plagued with accidents and deaths and is recognized as one of the most dangerous sections of highway in the UK. The final road solution and safety standards must be one of the determining factors for consideration over the life time of the scheme.

Option 30 offers the opportunity to optimize and integrate the new road into the environment. A factor that is very sensitive with both local communities as well as nationally.
