Dear

Please accept this email as my confirmation that the video clips I have sent you of various days in November/December this year of the practical effects of the rat running traffic around Birdlip and Brimpsfield are available as evidence in the examination of Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project.

Our property is between these two villages (GL4 1) and we have lived here for 21 years. In that time the rat run traffic has grown steadily worse, to the point that many times during the week, we will curtail our use of the road.

I have a business producing and educating young ponies and horses, which includes lots of riding out on the lanes to access the various local bridleways. The lanes have hedges on both sides and there are few places to pull off the road to allow traffic to pass. There is very little sight line ahead around the various corners, but despite this rat run traffic usually travels at 40mph and often quicker. It is striking that the general local use of the lanes tends to be much more considered and slower with much more time to react to any slower road users.

In the past few years the traffic has got so bad from 12-1pm through to 6pm that we do not dare take the ponies off site as the traffic that comes through our lanes increases 10 fold, and the drivers generally are not locals who are patient and considerate with horses on country lanes. I have had many instances where the ponies have been badly scared by inconsiderate and downright unpleasant
