 SUMMARY OF THE SCHEME
 The Application seeks development consent for the A417 Missing Link in the south-west region, located within the administrative areas of Gloucesterahire County Council, Tewkesbury Borough Council and Cotaweld District Council (The Scheme).

 The main aspects of the Scheme comprise:
