## **Procedural Decision in respect of site inspections**

As part of the Examination process, the ExA may undertake site inspections. These can be either unaccompanied or accompanied. The purpose of these is for the Examining Authority (ExA) to see features of the proposals within the context of the evidence put forward. As such, site inspections are a familiarisation exercise for the benefit of the ExA and are conducted at the discretion of the ExA. No discussion of the merits of the Proposed Development would be entertained during an Accompanied Site Inspection.

We note from the Applicant's recent <u>Additional Submission</u> with Examination Library reference [AS-062] that the Applicant believes that Accompanied Site Inspections may be beneficial to the Examination. The sites of FlyUp 417 Ltd, Stockwell Farm, and Emma's Grove are specifically mentioned with reference to the Applicant's '8.2¹ <u>Suggested Location for Site Inspections</u>' document submitted into the Examination at Deadline 1 with reference [REP1-007].

The ExA is in the process of organising site inspections to be conducted during the week commencing 28 February 2022, however the ExA is content that it is appropriate to conduct these inspections unaccompanied from public locations or with landowner consent where access to private land is required. The ExA wishes to emphasise that all suggested locations for site inspections submitted by Interested Parties at Deadline 1 have been afforded due consideration in determining which sites

the ExA deems it necessary to visit, as well as those orally stated during the first week of Hearings.
