The Cotswolds Conservation Board submitted it's Deadline 3 Written Representation yesterday. Within the document we responded to the ExA on matters concerning the proposed diversion of the Cotswold Way National Trail (R17 Request for Further Information on 13 January 2022).

However, since our submission we have been advised that National Highways is now considering disapplying s55(2) of the 1949 Act. Our initial impression is that this approach would also be acceptable. We will need to be assured of the continued engagement in the procedures, along with Natural England, Gloucestershire County Council and other members of the Cotswold Trails and Access Partnership.
