

ELECTRICITY SUPPLY TO COWLEY A letter was received from the Midlands Electricity Board stating that the cause of the varying voltage had been ascertained and a new Sub-station would be necessary. This would take some time as a considerable amount of work would be necessary, but in the meantime some minor modifications to the system would be carried out, which it was hoped would considerably alleviate the nuisance.

BIRDLIP (BARROW WAKE) BUS SHELTER The Clerk read a letter from the Birdlip Branch of the British Legion in which the action of the Parish Council in removing the seat from the bus shelter was criticised as being unnecessary and unauthorised by the Parish Meeting. The Clerk reported that he had sent a full explanation of the reasons for the removal of the seat, and also a detailed statement of the division of responsibilities between Parish Meeting and Parish Council, pointing out that the Parish Council were solely responsible for all matters connected with the provision of maintenance of bus shelters.
