**A417 Missing Link Examining Authority Questions 2**

I was a member of the Cotswold Conservation Board 2014-2020 and was an active member of their A417 working group during that period, and subsequently I have been assisting the CBA drafting their submissions. I am concerned that there are substantial issues that underlie the Examination Authority's second round of questions related to heritage and cumulative effects that have not been fully aired yet, and I hope this submission may assist you in your consideration of the proposals.

I am sorry it is so long, but as you will see the issues themselves are quite intricate and in my view the shortcomings that I seek to highlight are numerous and directly bear on key NPSNN policies in these fields. I include as appendices a summary of my own relevant experience and some outline assessments of setting issues and the possible significance of the Air Balloon public house which in my view have not been properly understood by the Applicant.
