Dear Oliver,

As discussed yesterday, there are two parts that need to be addressed before I am able to withdraw the holding objection/register of client's interest. You are already aware that Fisher German act on behalf of Severn Trent in this matter. For clarity, my client does not wish to object unnecessarily, and the nature of the objection is in the interest of protecting its assets and statutory function whilst the details are agreed.

From a practical/diversion element - I understand that Severn Trent have progressed the C4 quotes for the majority of the diversions, although may be subject to a price review between the parties. The affected assets should therefore be known to National Highways (I do not have a note of the plot reference number and/or works number for each of these).

From an asset protection element – I am unable to confirm whether the Protective Provisions Agreement within the dDCO is satisfactory and am liaising with Severn Trent legal to confirm next steps. I understand your legal team are also following this up.

Once I hear back, assuming the provisions are satisfactory, or if not, required amendments are made and agreed – my client should be in a position to withdraw it's holding objection in short order. I will forward a .pdf of this email to the planning inspectorate in response to their Rule 17 letter, dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and trust you will liaise over the detail.


