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1 INTRODUCTION

- **1.1** This Location Plan (this "Plan") relates to an application made by Highways England (the "Applicant") to the Secretary of State for Transport, via the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") under the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act") for a Development Consent Order (DCO). If made, the DCO would grant consent for the A1 in Northumberland: Morpeth to Ellingham (the "Scheme").
- 1.2 The Scheme comprises two sections known as Part A: Morpeth to Felton (Part A) and Part B: Alnwick to Ellingham (Part B). A detailed description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2: The Scheme of the Environmental Statement (ES) (Application Document Reference: TR010041/APP/6.1). Part A and Part B were originally proposed to be the subject of separate applications for DCOs but have now been combined into a single application for a DCO in respect of the Scheme as a whole and these Plans covers the Scheme in its entirety.
- **1.3** This Plan comprises part of a suite of application documentation and is included in the application in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(0) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (the "2009 Regulations") which requires


".... any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is being sought, showing details of design, external appearance and the preferred layout of buildings or structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping".

- 1.4 Although Regulation 5(2)(o) does not expressly mention location, the Inspectorate's Advice Note Six: Preparation and submission of application documents (February 2016: Version 7) suggests (at Appendix 1) that an application for development consent may include the submission of a location plan.
- **1.5** This Plan therefore has been included in the application to identify the location of the Scheme in its wider geographical context. As a consequence, these Plans use a smaller scale than that prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the 2009 Regulations but only so this wider geographical context can be represented on single sheet plans.
- **1.6** As the Plan is part of the application documentation, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other application documents.
