1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1. This updated gazetteer supersedes the gazetteer provided in the **Historic Environment Desk Based Assessment (HEDBA)** (completed in August 2018, refer to **Appendix 8.1, Volume 7** of this Environmental Statement (ES) (**Application Document Reference: TR010041/APP/6.7**)) and relates to the Scheme design for Part A: Morpeth to Felton (Part A) assessed as part of this ES. It is based on the data held in the National Heritage List for England (NHL) and the Northumberland Historic Environment Record (NHER).
- 1.1.2. An inner Study Area of 500 m extending out from the limits of the Order Limits was applied for the identification of all types of heritage assets (designated, non-designated and potential archaeological remains) to establish the known historic environment context and the potential for hitherto unknown below-ground archaeological remains (**Figure 8.1: Designated Heritage Assets, Volume 5** of this ES (**Application Document Reference: TR010041/APP/6.5**)).
- 1.1.3. A second, 1 km Study Area (outer Study Area) was applied for the assessment of the Settings of designated heritage assets and Conservation Areas (**Figure 8.2: Non-Designated Heritage Assets, Volume 5** of this ES (**Application Document Reference: TR010041/APP/6.5**)).
- 1.1.4. An indication of the value of the cultural heritage assets is provided in the **Tables 1-1 and 1-2** below based on the assessment undertaken to date.
- 1.1.5. The assessment of the value of cultural heritage assets involves consideration of how far the asset(s) contribute to an understanding of the past, through their individual or group qualities, either directly or potentially. These are professional judgements, but they are also guided by legislation, national policies, acknowledged standards, designations, criteria and priorities, as outlined in **Chapter 8: Cultural Heritage Section 8.4, Volume 2** of this ES (**Application Document Reference: TR010041/APP/6.2**). The assessment of value (also referred to as significance) is undertaken in line with DMRB guidance, and in compliance with the National Policy Statement for National Networks (NPS NN) and National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF).
- 1.1.6. The following a summary of the British archaeological and historical periods and their corresponding dates used in the **Tables 1-1 and 1-2 below**.
