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## 1 INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

1.1.1. The purpose of this document is to set out the locations that Highways England (the "Applicant") proposes the Examining Authority (ExA) visits as part of the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) in relation to the application for development consent for the A1 in Northumberland: Morpeth to Ellingham (the "Scheme").
1.1.2. The ExA has requested that the Applicant provide a suggested ASI itinerary by Procedural Deadline 2 on 29 January 2021.
1.1.3. The ASI is scheduled to take place on w/c 29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ March 2021.

### 1.2 STRUCTURE OF THIS DOCUMENT

1.2.1. This document comprises two chapters and two appendices, as follows:

1.2.2. The Applicant is proposing to undertake a risk assessment for the ASI. This has not yet been undertaken due to the existing Government guidance and restrictions in place in response to theCovid-19 pandemic. As it is not clear on whether the restrictions will remain in place in March 2021 there is some uncertainty on how the ASI might be best organised. However, the ASI itinerary proposed at Chapter 2 has assumed no restrictions will remain in place and a safety risk for those wishing to take part will be undertaken when restrictions are confirmed.

## 2 ITINERARY

### 2.1 ITINERARY

2.1.1. The proposed itinerary for the ASI is set out in Table 2-1 below. This includes timings and a description of what is to be observed at each location.
2.1.2. The ASI itinerary has been produced on the assumption that no restrictions will remain in place as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic. The Applicant proposes to keep this under review and will submit an updated version at Deadline 3 of the Examination if required.
2.1.3. On the assumption that there are no Covid-19 restrictions on attendees travelling together, the vehicle(s) will be provided by the Applicant for the ASI, although some of the locations will be observed on foot, possibly on uneven or wet ground. The itinerary refers to a 'bus', which will be used if it is possible to do so. If there are restrictions on travel and the ASI is still going ahead, then the itinerary may need to be revisited. There is limited parking at some of the proposed stop locations if all parties must travel in their own vehicles.
2.1.4. Part of the ASI will be undertaken on footpaths and by walking along local roads where there may not be a footway. Therefore, these elements of the ASI are subject to access being suitable for all attendees, to good visibility and to weather conditions being appropriate. Attendees should ensure that appropriate footwear and clothing are worn. The Applicant will provide high-visibility vests. There will be an option to stay in vehicles for the walking elements of the ASI.
2.1.5. The ASI will be within publicly accessible land as private land would only be accessible with the permission of the landowner.
2.1.6. The Applicant will bring any relevant plans or photomontages as well as an ASI brochure detailing the itinerary and providing health and safety advice.
2.1.7. A suggested Sign-In Sheet is included in Appendix A to confirm those attending have read and understood the safety briefing and to ensure accurate records of attendees.
2.1.8. A plan showing the proposed route and stop points is provided in Appendix B of this document.
