  - If there are any updates to the assessment of the impact of the scheme on the carbon budgets set out in the Applicant's response of January 2022, in particular to account for any revision in construction timetables and the Prime

Minister's announcement on 20 September postponing the ban on the sales of petrol and diesel cars to 2035.

- Any other updates to the environmental information produced in support of the application for the Development.
- Any other matters arising since 4 February 2022, which the Applicant consider are material for the Secretary of State to consider in his determination of the application.

Please could the **Applicant** and **Northern PowerGrid** confirm the position as regards the protective provisions. If an agreement has now been reached on the drafting of the protective provisions, please could the parties provide the agreed set of protective provisions and indicate if there are any differences between it and the protective provisions contained in the final draft development consent order [REP-003].
