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# A12 Chelmsford to A120 widening scheme POST DCO-APPLICATION SECTION 51 ADVICE AND SECTION 55 CHECKLIST RESPONSES

This document has been prepared by the Applicant in response to the Section 51 advice and Section 55 checklist issued by the Planning Inspectorate.

The first section is responses to the individual issues noted in the Section 51 advice and Section 55 checklist. The second section is a summary of any documentation changes.

# 1. Individual Responses

#### 1.1. Plans

17no plan sets have been flattened to improve accessibility.

#### 1.2. Consultees identified on a precautionary basis

### 1.3. Environmental Statement (Docs 6.1 to 6.4) - dormouse and bat surveys update

The surveys for dormouse and bats relating to the diversion of the Cadent gas main are programmed to continue into mid-November 2022 for dormouse and late September 2022 for bats. The outstanding dormouse surveys are required for a single landowner, who only permitted access for surveys late in the season, whereas dormice surveys for other landowners along the Cadent gas main were completed in early September. Although there were a few constraints on access for the other landowners, overall these have not compromised the results of the surveys. To date, no dormice have been recorded within the Cadent gas main survey area (182 dormouse tubes surveyed in 2022). The outstanding surveys relate to a parcel of land (containing 47 survey tubes) surrounded by other areas that were surveyed in 2022, so it seems unlikely dormice would be present.

The survey reports will be submitted to The Planning Inspectorate by 28 October (bats) and 9 December (dormice), and in advance of the likely date of the Preliminary Meeting.



The draft mitigation licence for bats was submitted to Natural England on 15 July 2022. On the assumption of a 30-working day response period we are due to receive a response imminently. Depending on the extent of comments received we would be hopeful of securing a Letter of No Impediment (LONI) before the end of the year. If the bat surveys for the Cadent gas main survey reveal bat features which would be impacted by the construction works, we would revise and reissue the draft mitigation licence for bats to Natural England and request a LONI. Given the programme indicated above, we would aim to reissue to draft mitigation licence before Christmas with a view to receiving the LONI in early to mid-February 2023.

Should dormice be recorded in the area still being surveyed, then our approach for dormice would be firstly to work with Cadent to determine whether a method of construction could be agreed to avoid impacts to dormice habitat. If this is not possible then we would prepare a draft licence application for review by Natural England, with a view to seeking a LONI from them. Should the DCO consent be granted, we would seek a licence from Natural England to remove dormouse habitat. Mitigation would include where practicable, timing of works including vegetation clearance to minimise impacts to dormice and provision of dormice boxes to improve the quality of retained habitat.
