I attach updated information for the Inspectors regarding traffic and accidents on the B1023 road. The traffic generated by the location of J24 access is of great concern to us and it is important that the Inspectors are aware of the current dangers caused by traffic through Inworth.

B1023 Inworth - recent accidents

These accidents clearly illustrate the unsuitability of this road for increased traffic and as a route to the proposed A12 Junction 24. Many vehicles exceed the speed limit and residents of Inworth are constantly at risk. Road closures to enable emergency services to deal with accidents would cause severe local traffic congestion.

30th November 2019

A car lost control on black ice and crashed. The driver was badly injured and had to be cut from the car by the emergency services. The road was closed for two hours.

The B1023 as it passes through Inworth is very dangerous especially in icy conditions, water drains down from the land on both sides.



8th November 2020

A car travelling from the Tiptree direction lost control and overturned. The road was closed while the emergency services dealt with the incident. This was posted on the Essex Police Facebook page and prompted many comments observing that the road is unsafe, uneven and difficult to negotiate for all road users including cyclists.



1st February 2023

A car travelling from Tiptree lost control and crashed in the centre of the village opposite the Red Dog restaurant. The driver was injured and was taken to hospital in an ambulance.
