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#### 4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application

The project lies wholly within England and involves the construction and alteration of a highway for which the applicant is the highway authority. It is an NSIP as defined within sections 14(1)(h), 22(1)(a) and 22(1)(b) of the PA 2008 as:

It comprises the construction and alteration of a highway;

• The highway to be constructed and altered is wholly within England;

- National Highways is the strategic highway authority for the highway;
- The speed limit will be 50mph or more and;

• The area of development exceeds the 12.5 hectares threshold.

Further clarification is provided in paragraphs 2.7 to 2.11 of the Explanatory Memorandum (Application Document 5.3) confirming that the application comprises development falling within the categories in s14 of the PA2008.

#### 5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The project is a programme of works to improve the A66 between the M6 at Penrith and the A1 at Scotch Corner. The project will involve upgrading single carriageway sections of road to dual carriageway standard and making improvements to the junctions along the route. Parts of the project involve online widening of the carriageway and some are offline (in other words, new sections of road that follow a different route but reconnect into the main A66 alignment).

The project is located in the North of England. The A66, provides the route between the M6 at Penrith, Cumbria and the A1(M) at Scotch Corner, Richmond, North Yorkshire The location of the project is illustrated on the Location Plan (Document Reference 5.12).
