**Issues**

1. General lack of commitment and certainty from National Highways to the final extent of land required for environmental mitigation and management prescription because of the uncertainty of the final permanent scheme.
2. The lack of clarity and certainty on specific permanent or temporary requirements.
3. In view of 2 above an entire lack of clarity on a plot-by-plot basis for the environmental mitigation areas of other mechanisms for management of and implementation of the relevant mitigation i.e. conservation covenant etc, which then remove the need for permanent acquisition.
4. The excessive amount of proposed environmental mitigation located on land that is rented at Winderwath Estate.
5. Any other issues that are raised from further research of the submitted documents.
