Adequacy of Consultations and Information provided by the Applicant

The Applicant has failed to provide sufficient information.

The Extent of Negotiations to Date

No meaningful negotiation has been carried out.

Access to Mainsgill Farm Shop

The environmental and financial costs of an additional junction at Brownson Bank cannot be justified

Land between Mainsgill Farm Shop and the re-Aligned A66

This represents the 'shop window' for Mainsgill Farm Shop.

Justification for the permanent acquisition of land or rights over land, and temporary land occupation; and the extent of those needs

We remain unclear that the Applicant requires all of the rights that they seek.

Proposed Ecological Mitigation Measures

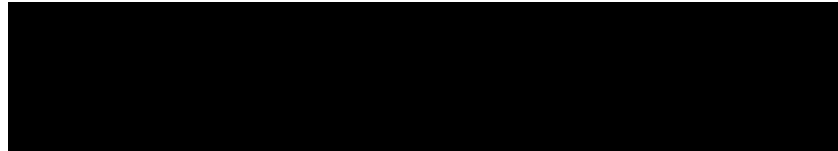
The areas identified for ecological mitigation appear to have been arbitrarily chosen.
