Proposed Ecological Mitigation Measures, and Location of Drainage Ponds, and Compounds

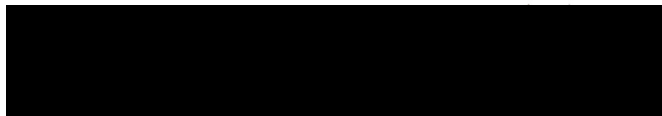
The areas identified appear to have been arbitrarily chosen.
