Adequacy of Consultations and Information provided by the Applicant

The Applicant has failed to provide sufficient information.

The Extent of Negotiations to Date

No meaningful negotiation has occurred.

Justification for the permeant acquisition of land or rights over land, and temporary land occupation; and the extent of those needs

We remain unclear that the Applicant requires all of the rights that they seek.

Drainage

Existing and future drainage concerns require addressing.

Creation of new Public Rights of Way

We are concerned at proposals to create a number of new public rights of way.

Access to A66 at Brownson Bank

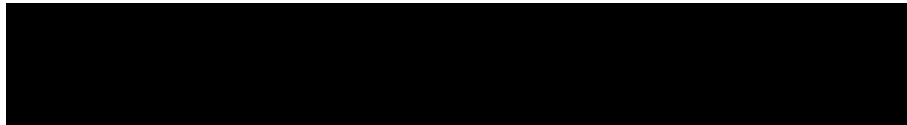
Opening an access at Brownson Bank poses a safety risk.
