2. Summary of Representations

Adequacy of Consultations and Information provided by the Applicant

The Applicant has failed to provide sufficient information.

The Extent of Negotiations to Date

To date, no meaningful negotiation has occurred.

Location of Proposed Junction with Long Marton Road

The proposed junction is not the most appropriate design.

Creation of new Public Rights of Way

We are concerned that the Applicant proposes to create new public rights of way.

Mitigation of Anti-Social Behaviour

The scheme creates areas of 'no-mans' inviting anti-social behaviour.

<u>Justification for the permeant acquisition of land or rights over land,</u> <u>and temporary land occupation; and the extent of those needs</u>



We remain unclear that the Applicant does require the rights that they seek.

Proposed Ecological Mitigation Measures, Ponds and Site Compounds

The areas identified for ecological mitigation, ponds and site compounds appear to have been arbitrarily chosen.

Liability for Infrastructure

The scheme should not impose any new liabilities.

Demonstration of the Availability of Necessary Funding

The Applicant has not properly considered the compensation that would be due.
