DCC's Deadline 1 submission included 'Appendix 1 – DCC Response to Examination Document PDL-013 (Response to Relevant Representations)'.

DCC notes the submission of the revised modelling contained in REP1-005 '7.2 Issue Specific Hearing 1 (ISH1) Post Hearing Submissions (including written submissions of oral case) Appendix 1 – Traffic Technical Note which was produced by National Highways in response to a request from the ExA during ISH1 held on 30 November 2022.

In general terms DCC supports the principle of dualling the remaining single carriageway sections of the A66 between Penrith and Scotch Corner as well as the proposed improvements to key junctions along the route. With regard to Schemes 7 and 8 within County Durham, DCC's relevant representation to PINS dated 31 August 2022 (Application Document RR-073) sets out the Council's position. As set out in Section 7 of DCC's Local Impact Report (REP1-021) the Council there is there is a need for the Applicant to continue liaising with DCC regarding the ongoing and final highway design of the scheme in relation matters such as, new or amended local highways, departures from standard, detrunking, stopping-up, construction works, traffic signing on DCC's highway network and legacy matters to include diversion routes, abnormal load routes and winter maintenance.
