A66 Northern Trans-Pennine Project: Application by National Highways ("the Applicant") for Development Consent ("DCO application")

Applicant's response to Procedural Decision by the Examining Authority ("ExA") (PD-008) dated 6 January 2023 regarding the Applicant's intention to submit a request for proposed changes to the DCO application

I refer to the ExA's Procedural Decision of 6 January 2023 in response to the Applicant's letter of 16 December 2022 informing the Examining Authority of our intention to submit a request for proposed changes to the DCO application ("the Change Notification letter").

Thank you for accepting that the Change Notification letter constitutes Step 1 of the six procedural steps set out in Figure 1 of the Planning Inspectorate's Advice Note 16 ("AN16"), and for confirming that PD-008 constitutes Step 2 and that the ExA is content with the nature and extent of the consultation proposed.

I note in particular your reference to Step 3, which requires an applicant to carry out non-statutory consultation before a written material change request is made, and your advice that the Applicant should begin its (non-statutory) consultation as soon as possible and submit any formal change request after any consultation is concluded.

The Applicant concurs that this approach would align with the process outlined in Figure 1 of AN16 and accepts the ExA's request to consult on the proposed changes, including those requiring "additional land" (as defined in the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 ("the CA Regulations")), before formally applying for them to be accepted into the Examination.

The Applicant also appreciates that the ExA would not wish to be put in the position of having to decide whether or not to accept any Proposed Provision submitted under the CA Regulations without having the benefit of knowing the outcome of representations submitted in response to consultation on that intended Proposed Provision (and, more generally, the outcome of the responses to consultation on the other proposed changes not requiring additional land).



The Applicant's consultation on all of the proposed changes is now planned to be launched on 28 January 2023, running to 23.59 on 27 February 2023. For a notice to be published in one of the relevant local newspapers concerned in time to start the consultation on 28 January 2023, the notice had to be finalised and submitted to the newspapers by 4pm last Friday 13 January 2023. This provides a consultation period of 31 days to ensure that, in the context of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017, sufficient time is made available for consultation on any environmental information arising in connection with the proposed changes.

The consequence of this approach is that there is considerable added pressure on the latter stages of the Examination period. In particular, there is little time within the remainder of the Examination period running until 29 May 2023 to run the consultation in respect of the proposed changes (i.e. the imminent consultation mentioned above) and then to publicise the Proposed Provision under the CA Regulations (if engaged and required), whilst still allowing time for the examination (through written submissions, and hearings if required) of the application inclusive of any changes proposed by the Applicant and then accepted by the ExA.

With this in mind the Applicant has prepared a suggested timetable regarding the submission of the proposed changes application (including the Proposed Provision) after the imminent consultation and indicating how the examination of the proposed changes, including any additional land identified in a Proposed Provision under the CA Regulations (if engaged and required), could be accommodated within the remainder of the six month Examination period. This is attached at the **Annex** to this letter.

The timetable demonstrates, in the Applicant's view, that the second round of hearings currently timetabled for the end of February and the beginning of March is positioned awkwardly in relation to the proposed changes (as the hearings will be just after consultation on the proposed changes has closed and whilst the Applicant is then considering the outcome of the consultation). The Applicant therefore suggests that it would be preferable for the hearings to be put back to later in the Examination in order to accommodate the altered Examination timetable that the proposed changes will result in. Doing so would also allow more time for progress to be made in negotiations with Interested Parties and Affected Persons generally and would, in the Applicant's view, therefore help to ensure the efficient use of Examination time and resource for all concerned.

The Applicant would welcome the ExA's consideration of this suggested timetable and any comments the ExA wishes to make on it, at the earliest possible opportunity.

As noted above, your earliest possible response is now needed.
