The land required for the Blue Route at Rokeby would cross a small area of woodland that has been felled and replanted. This area happens to be within a historic site, Rokeby Park and Gardens but its loss would not have a significant impact on the historic environment that is in the area. This factor means a minor known harm will for generations increase different harms in Startforth and Barnard Castle to its environment and people. At present these harms are not being judged as the historic one is the only one being considered.
