A66 NORTHERN TRANS-PENNINE PROJECT (THE PROJECT) POST EXAMINATION POSITION STATEMENT FROM THE APPLICANT ERRATA REPORT

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 On 25 August 2023, National Highways Limited (**the Applicant**) submitted to the Secretary of State a Post Examination Position Statement on Habitats Regulations Assessment and North Pennine Moors SAC, and subsequent appendices (**the Applicant's Position Statement**), as part of its response to the Secretary of State's Request for Information dated 11 August 2023.
- 1.2 The Applicant's Position Statement referred to certain areas of land as being owned by the Ministry of Defence, whereas the Applicant can now confirm this land was in fact owned by the Public Trustee.
- 1.3 The Applicant is therefore submitting this Errata Report to provide an update on the two identified land interests (**the Errata**), which is minor in nature and does not change the meaning, analysis, assessment or conclusions of the Applicant's Position Statement.
- 1.4 The Errata can be found in the table in section 2 below, where a correction is provided for clarification. A strikethrough has been used to show text which can be removed from the documents, whilst text in red is new and altered text.
- 1.5 As the Errata identified are minor in nature, the Applicant's Position Statement has not been reissued. As such, the Applicant's Position Statement, as available on the Project's page of the Planning Inspectorate's National Infrastructure Planning website, remains unchanged; however, it should be referenced against the changes contained within this document.
