<u>Planning Act 2008 – Application by National Highways Limited for the A66 Northern Trans-Pennine Development Consent Order (TR010062) – Withdrawal of Objection</u>

I write on behalf of John Richard Lane, James Hare, Alan Moore Bowe and Sarah Crane, being the Trustees of the Winderwath 1989 Settlement Trust (the "Trustees"), as their agent in respect of the above referenced application for development consent.

The draft Development Consent Order, if made, would authorise the compulsory acquisition of land, rights over land and the temporary possession of land and the extinguishment and temporary suspension of private rights over land, in which the Trustees hold an interest.
