Planning Act 2008 – TR010063 – M5 Junction 10 Improvements Scheme: Application for a Development Consent Order

On behalf of Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) (“the Applicant”), please find enclosed an application under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (“the Act”) for a Development Consent Order (DCO) granting development consent for the proposed M5 Junction 10 Improvements Scheme (the “Scheme”).

The Scheme amounts to a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (“NSIP”) under section 22 (3) of the Planning Act 2008. Further details concerning the Scheme’s qualification as an NSIP is provided in box 4 of the Application Form (application document TR010063 – APP 1.2) and in the Explanatory Memorandum (application document TR010063 – APP 3.2).

Description of the Scheme

The Scheme falls within the administrative boundaries of Gloucestershire County Council, Cheltenham Borough Council and Tewkesbury Borough Council. In summary, the Scheme will provide:

- an all-movements junction at M5 Junction 10;
- the construction of a new West Cheltenham Link Road east of Junction 10 from the A4019 to B4634; and
- the widening of the A4019 to the east of Junction 10, including a bus lane on the A4019 eastbound carriageway from the West Cheltenham Fire Station to the Gallagher Junction.

A detailed description of the Scheme is provided in the Introduction to the Application (application document TR010063 – APP 1.1) and Chapter 2 of the Environmental Statement (application document TR010063 – APP 6.2).

Compulsory Acquisition

The draft DCO (dDCO) includes compulsory acquisition and temporary possession powers to acquire land, rights over and interests in land and other related powers necessary to construct, operate and maintain the Scheme, including land that is held by a Crown interest. Details of the power sought and the reasons for requiring the land and other interests in land

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are set out in the Explanatory Memorandum (application document TR010063 – APP 3.2) and the Statement of Reasons (application document TR010063 – APP 4.1).

Consultation

As required by section 37(3)(c) of the Act, a Consultation Report (application document TR010063 – APP 5.1) and Consultation Report Appendices (application documents TR010063 – APP 5.2) accompany this application.

The Scheme has been designed and developed following extensive consultation and engagement with local communities, statutory bodies, landowners and other interested parties. The Applicant has undertaken five rounds of consultation, including:

- one round of non-statutory consultation on Scheme options;
- a statutory consultation on design; and
- 3 subsequent rounds of targeted consultation covering changes in the Scheme design.

This consultation with key stakeholders and the local community has been undertaken to provide opportunities for interested parties to comment on the proposals whilst they were at a formative stage before finalising the design which is now the subject of this application.

Application formalities

In preparing the application, the Applicant has had full regard to relevant government guidance, Planning Inspectorate Advice Notes and other advice provided by the Planning Inspectorate under section 51 of the Planning Act 2008. The application contains all of the information required under the relevant legislation, including the Planning Act 2008, The Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 and The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017.

The Applicant can confirm that, in line with the relevant regulations, the application plans that are submitted have been prepared at no larger than A0 (original print size), have been drawn to a recognised scale, show the direction of north and include suitable key plans where necessary.

The Applicant has completed its own Schedule of Compliance with Section 55 Checklist (application document TR010063 – APP 1.3). The Applicant hopes you find this helpful in undertaking your acceptance and compliance checks.

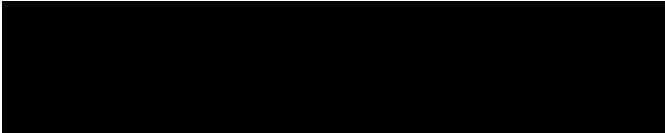

4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application

Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

The Scheme is a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project ("NSIP") under sections 14(1)(h) and 22(1)(a) of the Planning Act 2008 (the "Act").
Under section 14(1)(h) of the Act "highway-related development" constitutes an NSIP.
Under section 22(1) of the Act highway-related development is within section 14(1)(h) only if the development falls within one of three specified categories: construction of a highway in a case within subsection (2), alteration of a highway in a case within subsection (3) or improvement of a highway in a case within subsection (5).
The Scheme includes alterations to Junction 10 of the M5 motorway, which is part of the strategic highway network. It therefore constitutes the "alteration" of a highway within the meaning of section 22(3). The Scheme meets the requirements of this definition under section 22(3) as follows:
(a)The highway is wholly in England (section 22(3)(a));
(b)National Highways (the strategic highways company) is the highway authority for the highway (section 22(3)(b)); and
(c)The area of development is approximately 53 hectares, which is greater than the relevant limit set out in subsection (4), in this case being 15 hectares as the M5 is a motorway (sections 22(3)(c) and 22(4)(a)).
As the Scheme is an NSIP development consent must be obtained from the Secretary of State for Transport to authorise it, and an application for a development consent order must be made to the Planning Inspectorate ("PINS"), who administer the DCO process on behalf of the Secretary of State, under section 37 of the Act.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

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The Scheme includes three elements comprising of alterations to M5 Junction 10, widening along the A4019 and construction of a new Link Road to West Cheltenham.

The alterations to M5 Junction 10 consist of a new all-movements elongated roundabout junction. Two new overbridges will be constructed over the M5, centred either side of the existing Piffs Elm Interchange Bridge (carrying the A4019 over the M5), which will then be demolished. An underpass will also be constructed under the A4019 immediately east of Junction 10 to provide a traffic free route for bats to cross under the road, as well as pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians. To the southeast of M5 Junction 10, an area of land will be reprofiled to provide compensatory flood storage for the Scheme.

The A4019 will be widened to a two-lane dual carriageway from Withybridge Lane, eastwards to the Gallagher Retail Park, where the scheme will tie into existing dual carriageway. The widening will also include a bus lane on the A4019 eastbound carriageway from the West Cheltenham Fire Station to the Gallagher Junction. Three new junctions will be created along this road, as well as some changes to existing junctions and includes segregated pedestrian and cyclist facilities. The A4019 will be realigned to provide appropriate entry angle to the new roundabout, and the grade of the A4019 will also be altered to meet the raised elevation of the altered M5 Junction 10.

The Scheme will also provide a new single carriageway link road between the B4634 to the A4019 in order to allow traffic from the West Cheltenham development to use M5 Junction 10 and thereby reduce pressure on Junction 11 and local roads. The Link road will include a segregated cycleway and footway, and a single span bridge will be constructed over the River Chelt.

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development

M5 Junction 10 is located 48 miles to the south of Birmingham, 40 miles to the north of Bristol, 5 miles to the south of Tewkesbury, 4 miles to the north-west of Cheltenham, and 8 miles to the north-east of Gloucester.

The grid references provided in the boxes below relate to the linear M5 extent of the works. The Scheme relates to an intersection of two linear highways and a new link road, the grid references for these are as follows.
