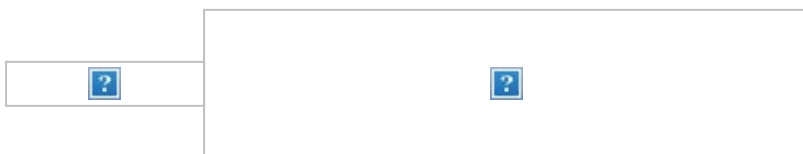
Dear Jess
