Application by National Highways for the A46 Newark Bypass Project

Examining Authority's record of an Unaccompanied Site Inspection (USI) to which the application or specified matters relate

Examining Inspectors Ken Stone, Paul Burley, and David Love (the Examining Authority (ExA) appointed by the Secretary of State for the application of the A46 Newark Bypass Project) undertook a second USI on Wednesday 9 October 2024. The USI was undertaken only from publicly-accessible land to view the area subject to the proposed development, the existing road network and the historic environment. Further USIs may or may not take place during the Examination.

Particulars of the Site Inspection

Wednesday 9 October 2024

Time: 1430

Weather conditions: Heavy rain, overcast, light breeze. Visibility acceptable.

The ExA observed Smeaton's Arches just north of the Cattle Market roundabout. After leaving they travelled north east along the A46 to the Esso service station on Lincoln Road to refamiliarise themselves with the southern extent of the Winthorpe Conservation Area.
